Are you anticipating this Sunday? It's Heritage Sunday. We will all worship together in one service at 11:00 a.m. (Sunday School will meet at its usual time.) We will experience the gifts of our church family from both the Remedy Campus, and our main campus as we "sing to the Lord;" eat together, and enjoy a fun-filled afternoon. Since Heritage Sunday is our form of "homecoming," please consider inviting those who might respond to an invitation from you to this special day: former members, family, and friends. It's a great opportunity to invite someone new!

This Sunday we will begin a new sermon series called, "Unstoppable." We're going to focus on our Unstoppable Mission of "helping people follow Jesus."
