From the Pastor's Desk

It's hard to believe we are already wrapping up the month of May, heading into the Summer. I've learned the month of June is a busy time here at Fairview with: Youth Choir Tour taking off this weekend, the Youth Choir Concert on June 10, our denomination's Holston Annual Conference June 10-13 at Lake Junaluska, Vacation Bible School June 10-14, and Music and Drama Camp after that. Our church family, especially children and youth, have an amazing month ahead. I hope you will be prayerfully supportive of each of these ministries, and physically present and engaged wherever possible.

This Sunday we are going to have the second message in a two-week series: "I'm Working On It." We're talking about "Attitude," and how Romans, chapter 8, has much to say to us that can shape positive attitudes in each of us. One of the key points I sought to make last Sunday, was "My attitude is based on what God's says, not what I feel." The four statements we looked at on Sunday were: my sins are forgiven, my mind is filled with the peace of God, my future victory is greater than my present pain, and God's Spirit helps me in my weakness. I hope you will choose to be present this Sunday as we worship God, and as we delve into the second of four attitudes we find in Romans 8. We will also celebrate Holy Communion on Sunday; just a reminder - this year on Communion Sundays, when we come forward to receive Holy Communion, we have an opportunity to bring an offering for Local Missions - you may want to plan accordingly.

On June 10, in addition to our Youth Choir leading worship on the main campus, our morning offering will go to missions (this includes regional, national and global missions). Unless you designate your offering for some other designated ministry, all undesignated giving will support missions. It takes over \$112,000 annually to fund our regional, national and global missions. The church budget allocates \$60,000 annually (to regional, national and global missions). The remaining \$35,000 is funded through two special offerings during the calendar year. The first offering this year is June 10, the second in October.

As we head into the Summer, I hope you will plan to be present in worship every Sunday you can. Taking a vacation from other routine parts of our lives should not mean we take a vacation from the very thing God created us to do, and that is to be engaged in worshipping God with other believers.

I look forward to worshipping with you, and to the month ahead!
