From the Pastor's Desk

For the last few weeks we've been looking at one of the best-known passages of Scripture in the whole Bible, Psalm 23. We've read it in the silence of our own souls, we've said it aloud as an affirmation of faith, and we've heard it spoken on many occasions to bring comfort. And, to some degree, because of those different experiences, we may have thought we were pretty familiar with it.

This series, "Is the Lord *Your* Shepherd?" has been one of my favorites and, judging from the feedback we've been receiving, you have connected with it as well. Thank you for your feedback. Thank you for sharing with us how you have become engaged with it, and how God has spoken to you over the last few weeks.

We've learned the 23rd Psalm is comprehensive in nature. It begins with the bold declaration: "The Lord is my shepherd." It ends with one equally bold, "Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life, and I will dwell in the house of the Lord forever." We've learned this psalm addresses our spiritual, directional, emotional, and physical needs. This Sunday, we're going to wrap it all up with our eternal needs.

I know Fall Break for most of our schools will be underway, but I hope if you are in town, and able, you will make every effort to be present to worship with others. If you are unable to come to worship, or, if you are out of town, please join us online. A number of our folks who are unable to be physically present in worship, tell me how they Livestream the service and participate in the scripture readings and in the sermon points. We are blessed to be able to offer this resource!

I also want to ask you to be mindful of this year's Mission Sunday, on October 21. We are changing the format this year. Missions has long been one of the things we value most about our life together and ministry here at Fairview. This year, we will worship together on Mission Sunday in one service (Remedy Service and main campus together) at 11:00 a.m. During the Sunday School hour, our gym will be set up for us to pack 400 buckets with food items for our Food Distribution in Sneedville, TN in the month of December; this experience will provide a great opportunity for us to come together in one mission event. The Great Hall will also be set up with displays and representatives from some of the different mission organizations we support. Also, all of our morning offering (unless otherwise designated by you), will go to support our mission presence in the world. It's going to be a great day! Please, put October 21, 11:00 a.m. on your calendar as a Sunday you don't want to miss.

I look forward, with gladness, to entering into the House of the Lord with you this Sunday!
